Materials

(Fiber quantities are listed for making one pictures, not both)

Merino Short Fiber Batting, 19-micron 1 oz of Fir (Background Canvas Color)

Merino Top, 19.5-micron
½ oz each of: Fir, Evergreen

If making Blue Macaws:

½ oz of True Blue

1/4 oz each of Sun, Bali, Ebony, White Sand

If making Red Macaws:

½ oz of **Red**

1/4 oz each of Bordeaux, Sun, True Blue, White Sand, Ebony

Merino Silk Blends
½ oz of Honey Dew

1/4 oz of Pueblo

Viscose Top
Blue Macaw: ¼ oz each of Sun, White

Red Macaw: ¼ oz each of Red, Sun, White

Bamboo Top¼ oz of Citrus

Tools

Clear Vellum Paper Optional (For tracing birds and using as guides)

Olive Oil Soap

Ball Brause

Power Sander
Optional (Alternatives are a Palm Washboard, or your hands

Plastic Sheet or <u>Bubble Wrap</u>
2 pieces measuring at least 15 x 19 inches

• Felting Needles 36T, 40T

• Felting Pad 17 in x 17 in recommended

Additional Tools/Items

Towels, Warm Water and Bowl

Optional: 11 x 14 frame, foam or board picture mount backing, Acid-free spray adhesive photo mount or Velcro
